The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Technical Delegate (Document No. 01.01), have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Driver and car No: No. 74 Javier VILLA

Competitor: Javier VILLA

Time: 20:15

Session: During initial scrutineering

Fact: The PF value, as determined during initial scrutineering, differs from the technical sheet. By recalculating the PF number, the result changes the classification of the car from Group 2 to Group 1.

Offence: Breach of Article 9.1.4 of the 2026 Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship

Decision: Warning

Reason: Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the PF Technical Sheet submitted by the Competitor was not accurate, thus resulting in a breach of Article 9.1.4 of the 2026 Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship. That being, pursuant to Articles 15.3.1 of the 2026 Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship, if an error or incorrect data is discovered during scrutineering, the error must be corrected on the PF Technical Sheet in order to create the car's new PF number. If the new PF obtained classifies the car in a different group to the one in which the Competitor is entered, only one group change per season following an error or incorrect data is accepted according to Article 15.3.4 of the 2026 Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship. Therefore, having considered that this is the Competitor's first infringement of this kind during the current season, a Warning is imposed and no points will be deducted from the Competitor's Championship classifications.

Competitors are reminded of their right of appeal in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
