REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which shall be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 1 – Organisation

The Competition, which has the status of an International Competition, shall be run in conformity with:

- The International Sporting Code ("the Code") and its Appendices,
- the National Sporting Code where applicable,
- the official FIA Bulletins,
- the General Prescriptions applicable to International Hill Climb Competitions,
- the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship and its Appendices ("the Sporting Regulations"), and
- these Supplementary Regulations.

Characteristics of the Competition:

- Number of practice heats: **3** (Saturday)
- Warmup: **1** (Sunday)
- Number of official race heats: **2**
- Any Driver must mandatorily complete at least one practice heat in order to be allowed to start the race. Special cases shall be submitted to the stewards.
- Driver classifications shall be established by combining the times of each Driver's two best race heats.

Licence requirements:

Category 1 Drivers: Car driving licence and Grade D International Licence minimum (ITD-R).

Category 2 Drivers: Car driving licence and Grade C International Licence (ITC-R).

Competitors: International.

National/International Licence Equivalence:

The Organising ASN's National Licence has the same value as an International Licence for the Competition counting towards the FIA Championship only.

The following entry conditions must be respected:

- The Driver has proven experience with the car entered (minimum of 3] previous participations with the same car during the last 24 months).

Rejections, Withdrawals:

In the event that an entry is rejected or the Competition is cancelled, the entry fees shall be reimbursed in full.

In case of withdrawal for reasons of Force Majeure (no-show for administrative checking and scrutineering) after the publication of the entry list, 50% of the base entry fees shall be reimbursed to



the Competitor(s), subject to receipt of a written request.

Article 4 – Obligations of Participants

An additional set of Competition numbers (maximum height 15 cm) must be placed on the right side of the windscreen (or, if the car has no windscreen, on a forward-facing part of the car) and on the left side of the rear window.

Cars without their correct Competition numbers shall not be allowed to take the start.

Article 6 – Insurance

In accordance with legal requirements, the organiser has taken out one or more insurance policies against the following risks:



- Third Party Insurance in the amount of €2 225 000 approx. (10 000 000 PLN) for the event.

- Other: Accident insurance - coverage in the event of permanent damage to the health of 20 000 PLN (€4500 approx.) for members of the organizer personnel.

The organiser's third-party insurance is valid for the entire duration of the Competition, not only during official practice and race heats but also for travelling from the parking area to the course of the Competition and back.

Article 7 – Protests, reviews, and appeals

7.1 Protests

Protests must be filed in accordance with Art. 13 ISC.

Amount of the protest deposit: €500.

7.2 Appeals Fee & Deposit

Appeals must be lodged in accordance with Art. 15 ISC and Art. 14 JDR.

Amount of the appeal fee: €3,000 for organisation or other entity, or €1,000 for natural persons, in accordance with Art. 14.1.2 JDR.

Amount of the appeal deposit: €6,000 for organisation or other entity or €3,000 for natural persons, in accordance with Art. 14.1.2 JDR

7.3 Right of Review

Petitions for review must be filed in accordance with Art. 14 ISC.

Amount of the review deposit: €1,500

Article 8 – Podium, Prizes and Awards:

8.1 Trophies and Cash prizes

The classifications shall be established and shall entail the distribution by the organiser of awards and cash prizes as follows:

8.2 Special prizes

Special prizes shall be awarded by the organiser as follows:

8.3 Trophies

a) In groups with fewer than 3 starters, only the Driver who finishes first shall receive a trophy.

b) All trophies are cumulative and may be combined with one another and with other prizes awarded by the organiser in the other jointly-organised Competitions.

c) Awarding of prizes:

- Trophies are awarded during the podium ceremony.



8.4 Cash Prizes

a) Cash Prizes shall be awarded regardless of the number of Drivers who take the start.

b) All cash prizes are cumulative and may be combined with one another and with other prizes awarded by the Organiser in the other jointly organised Competitions.

c) Awarding of prizes:

- Cash prizes must be collected from the following location:

Location: Scene near Service Park - Stara Wieś (the official ceremony of prize giving)

At the Competition Secretariat – School Complex No. 1 – handing over a cash prize

Time: up to 60' after the podium ceremony.

failing which they shall be retained by the Organiser.

Article 9 – Additional provisions by the organiser

9.1 In special justified cases the organiser will allow additional administrative checks and scrutineering after 18:00 on 17.07.2026 for an additional 300 PLN (€70 approx.) payment. Additional administrative checks and scrutineering will be held on 18 July 2026, 06:00hrs

9.2 The dates and place of subsequent Stewards meetings will be established at the first meeting and will be published on the official notice board.

9.3 At all times during the Competition the maximum speed limit inside the Service Park and Upper Machine Park is 30 km/h. Any breach of the speed limit, by the competitor/driver and/or his team personnel and/or his accompanying persons, within

the confines of the Service Park, will be treated as an offence and a penalty will be imposed, CoC, and in repeated violations of the regulation determined by the Stewards.

9.4 At all times during the Competition there is a strict ban on crossing the middle of the service road with a competitor's service (tents, etc.) -

EMERGENCY ROUTE / yellow dots in the middle of the road - any violation of the above rule will result in a fine of 1,000 euros (4,500 PLN) for the Competitor. Penalty will be imposed, CoC, and in repeated violations of the regulation determined by the Stewards.

9.5 All the competitors/drivers are required to use a protective sheet under their cars, to prevent damage and pollution of the ground by petroleum-derived materials.

9.6 All competitors are obliged to keep a fire extinguisher, with min. of 4 kg of extinguishing agent, within immediate reach of their service positions.

9.7 Each competitor/driver who attends the Awards ceremony is obliged to present him/herself clothed in the appropriate Motor Sport outfit with overalls buttoned/zipped and with the correct footwear.

In addition, competitors and their Team members are obliged to behave in a proper manner during the Award Ceremony.

9.8 The entry to the race is the conclusion of a civil law contract with the organizer. It also means the consent of the competitor / driver for the processing of his personal data for purposes related to the organization of the above race, and the whole series of competitions in which the race is organized. This application also means consent to the publication of photographs containing competitor / driver image and his/her results on the PZM website as well as other websites of the organizers of the rounds of each competition series under which the competition is organized. A Competitor / Driver has the right to access his / her personal data, correct them and request to cease processing of these data. A request to cease processing of his / her personal data means resignation from participation in the competition.
